Whereas, There has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery Alabama, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "to secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Robert B. Billings has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the the fractions "B" and "6" of section thirty four in Township twenty two South of Range thirteen West of the Huntsville Meridian in Alabama containing ninety five acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Robert B. Billings the tract of Land above described, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Robert B. Billings and to his heirs and assigns forever.
