To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

**Whereas,** *Treyvant De Graffenried of Greene County*  
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Tusculoosa*  
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Treyvant De Graffenried*  
according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for  
*The East-half of the South West quarter of Section Seventeen, in Township twenty three, of Range one West*  
*in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Tusculoosa Alabama, containing eighty, six and ten*  
*and a half hundredths of an acre*  
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-  
chased by the said *Treyvant De Graffenried*

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the  
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said *Treyvant De Graffenried*  
and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: To  
Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said *Treyvant*  
*De Graffenried* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
