**Whereas** *Jethro Harrison of Greene County*  
has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa  
whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *Jethro Harrison*  
according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for  
the west half of the South west quarter of Section twenty two in Township twenty three  
of Range One west in the district of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa  
Alabama containing eighty Acres and Nineten hundredths of an Acre  
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-  
chased by the said *Jethro Harrison*

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the  
several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *Jethro*  
*Harrison* and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described:

To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said  
*Jethro Harrison* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
