according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

~~Range One East in the District of Lands subject to sale at Pascalona & Hatama containing Thirty one~~
~~Acre and ninety two hundred acres of an Acre,~~
according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-
chased by the said *Barry Bennett*.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the
several acts of Congress, in such cases made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said *Barry
Bennett* and to his heirs, the said tract above described:
To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said
Barry Bennett and to his heirs and assigns forever.
