To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Robert Daniel and to his heirs, the said tract above described: and to his heirs, the said tract above described: and to his heirs and assigns forever.
