WHEREAS

*Kenith Carpenter of Pickens County*has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the **REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE** at *Tuscaloosa* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said*Kenith Carpenter*

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

*the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section One in Township twenty four of Range One East in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing forty acres and two hundredths of an acre*according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR****GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Kenith Carpenter***NOW KNOW YE**, That the**United States of America**, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said *Kenith Carpenter*and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Kenith**Carpenter*and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.**In Testimony Whereof, I,***Martin Van Buren***PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, have caused these Letters to be made **PATENT**, and the **SEAL** of the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be hereunto affixed.**GIVEN** under my hand at the **CITY OF WASHINGTON**, the *twentieth* day of *September* in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *thirty nine* and of the **INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES** the Sixty *fourth***BY THE PRESIDENT:***Martin Van Buren*
