 The West half of the North West quarter of Section twenty two, in Township twenty-  
 four, of Range one West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama,  
 containing Eighty Acres  
 according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-  
 chased by the said Joshua Birmingham

 several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Joshua Birmingham

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said  
 Joshua Birmingham  
 and to his heirs, the said tract above described:  
 and to his heirs and assigns forever.
