the North East quarter of the South West quarter and the North West quarter of the South East quarter of Section twenty one, in Township twenty four, of Range two East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing seventy nine acres and ninety two hundredths of an acre,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
