Whereas, There has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery,

Alabama, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "to secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Miles Burton has

been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the West half of the South West quarter of Section five and the South East quarter of the South East quarter of Section six in Township twenty-four North of Range two East of St. Stephens Meridian in Alabama, containing one hundred and nineteen acres and eighty-four hundredths of an acre.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

Miles Burton

the tract of Land above described, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Miles Burton and to his heirs and assigns forever.
