Whereas, There has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery,
Alabama,

whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "to secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Marion Burton

has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law, for the North West quarter
of the North East quarter of Section nine in Town-
ship twenty-four North of Range two East of St.
Stephens Meridian in Alabama, containing thirty-
nine acres and ninety-five hundredths of an
acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Marion Burton

the tract of Land above described, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Marion Burton and to his heirs and assigns forever.
