Whereas Joseph Phillips, of Tuscaloosa County,

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of THE REGISTER OF THE LAND
OFFICE at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said

Joseph Phillips, according to the provisions of the
Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for
the South West quarter of the North East quarter, and the
North West quarter of the South East quarter of Section
thirty one, in Township twenty four, of Range three,
East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing Seventy nine acres,
and eighty hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL,
which said tracts have been purchased by the said Joseph Phillips,

United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case
made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

Joseph Phillips,

and to his heirs, the said tracts above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges,
immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Joseph Phillips,

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
